Information for Exhibitors:

- Please see General Rules and Regulations page 7 & 8.
- Pre-registration required.
- All entry forms due at the fair office by 4 pm on the Monday prior to the Fair.
- **Online entries** due by Noon on Tuesday the week of the fair.
- ALL WORK MUST BE DONE BY THE EXHIBITOR UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED.
- Items to exhibit must be brought in between 6 pm & 9 pm Wednesday night September 11, or Thursday morning September 12 between 8 am and 10 am.
- Sunday: Exhibit Hall closes at 4 pm to prepare for pickup of exhibits.
- No exhibits to be removed from exhibit building before Sunday 4:30 pm.
- Each entry must not be previously entered.
- No student may enter more than one object per section.
- Food - All food must be displayed on a disposable plate and covered with transparent wrap. All decorations must be edible.
- Vegetables - when selecting vegetables consider uniformity, size, colour, trueness to shape and correct number requested.
- Flowers – when selecting flowers consider uniformity, condition, no insects or disease and correct number.
- Fair share exempts for all Junior Work Exhibits.

Class 8 - Vegetables

Divided by Grade JK – 2, Grade 3-6, Grade 7 - 12

Sections:

1. Potatoes (3)
2. Carrots (3)
3. Cucumbers (2)
4. Tomatoes (3): with calyx, full size Not mini
5. Odd shaped vegetable (1)
6. Vegetable Vehicle: combination of whole or carved vegetables and/or fruit in a solid container or on tray
7. A creature made from garden produce and other natural materials in a solid container or on tray

Junior Work – Classes 9, 10

Class 9 - Flowers

Divided by Grade JK – 2, Grade 3-6, Grade 7 - 12

Sections:

1. Marigolds: (3) blooms
2. Zinnias: (3) blooms
3. Petunias (5) blooms
4. Pansies: (3) blooms, any colour(s)
5. Dahlia under 5": (3) blooms, any colour(s)
6. Most unique flower
7. Floral arrangement: minimum of (3) garden varieties of flowers (buds and greenery may be used)
8. Bottoms up: an artistic floral arrangement in a mug (buds and greenery may be used)
9. Artistic arrangement: using natural materials from field and woods (buds may be used) container appropriate to the arrangement, but not necessarily a natural material
10. Fantasy Garden no more than 30cm x 30cm (12" x 12")

Class 10 - Baking

Displayed on study paper plate and encased in clear plastic

Grade JK to 2

Decorations done by exhibitor unassisted (only decorating will be judged)

Sections:

1. Decorated sugar cookies (3)
2. Decorated cupcakes (3)

Grade 3 - 6

Judged on appearance and taste

Sections:

3. Rice Krispies squares (1)
4. Chocolate chip cookies – (3) - no larger than 7.5cm (3") each
5. Butter tarts (3) – no nuts or raisins

Grade 7 - 12

Judged on appearance and taste

Sections:

6. Brown sugar fudge square (2) no nuts
7. Brownie squares: (3) iced (no nuts)
8. Any Apple Desert – (one serving) main ingredient must be apples, Ex. Apple pie, apple crisp, apple turnover
9. Butter tarts (3) – no nuts or raisins
